<ul> <li>Plain red jumper or cardigan</li> <li>Dark grey or black trousers, skirt or pinafore</li> <li>Red checked dress</li> <li>Sensible black shoes (no flip-flops or strappy sandals)</li> <li>No jewellery to be worn, only small stud earrings.</li> <li><u>Small</u> bows in school colours (red, white, black or grey)</li> <li>No nail polish, gel nails or acrylic nails</li> <li>You can also purchase embroidered uniform from Uniform Direct.</li> </ul>	These <u>must</u> be in school every day. Children must bring in their own PE kit from home. PE kit includes: • A T-shirt (no crop-tops) • Shorts or joggers • Plimsolls or trainers All children must change for PE. PE kit must not have any inappropriate pictures or logos. Each child must have their own Micropore tape if their ears have recently been pierced. Alternatively, children can take our their earrings for PE. Only small studs are permitted.	<ul> <li>This needs to be brought to school every day with your child's current reading book.</li> <li>Please listen to your child read at least 5 times a week.</li> </ul>
